1. The meeting was called to order by Chairman Jonson at 10:00 a.m. Introductions were made.
2. Mr. Tindall noted that the right of way had been mowed, but not weed whacked. He also stated that the palm trees should be trimmed.
3. No action was taken on the previous meeting's minutes.
4. Mr. Jonson informed the Committee that construction of the Pinellas portion of the trail is on schedule, that a letter thanking Keep Tampa Bay Beautiful was in progress, and that the City of Clearwater was committed to hosting a ribbon-cutting ceremony to coincide with the City's centennial celebration. The Committee confirmed existing revisions to the Corridor Management Plan Goals and discussed supporting an effort by the City of Clearwater to acquire property to accommodate a trail connection and safe SR60 crossing. Mr. Palozzi offered to review the Courtney Campbell Scenic Highway website and provide suggested enhancements.
5. The Committee heard a detailed presentation by Ms. Roberts on issues (noise, parking, alcohol, signage) surrounding a rezoning and special use petition for Hogan's Beach. Although no formal action was taken, several individuals offered assistance.
6. The Committee agreed to continue to meet, as needed, on the 3rd Friday of every month.
