1. The meeting was called to order by Chairman Jonson at 10:05 a.m. Introductions were made.
2. Mr. Tindall made several remarks about the lack of maintenance on the ROW on the western portion of the Courtney Campbell Causeway. Ms. Leonard concurred, noting encroachments on to the adjacent service road and the need to control Australian Pines and Brazilian Pepper. She committed to following up on the issue and updating Mr. Jonson and Ms. Marable.
3. There being no corrections to the published minutes, upon a motion by Mr. Hoyt, the summary of the September 26, 2014 meeting was approved.
4. Ms. Leonard stated that the Clearwater Trail Connection Bridge project is on the bottom of the grant list. The project requires the acquisition of additional right of way to accommodate a helix structure.
5. Trail construction continues to be on schedule. The ribbon cutting ceremony will be coordinated by Clearwater Parks and Recreation and will likely be staged east of the water treatment plant. A list of CCSH CAC accomplishments should be included in any press releases.
6. It was determined that the CCT is not suitable for a timed athletic event (such as Iron Man), but would be able to support charitable events (such as Relay for Life). Mr. Hoyt requested that this information be verified by Iron Man officials.
7. Mr. Jonson will coordinate an official letter to Keep Tampa Bay Beautiful with Ms. Price. It was also suggested that the CAC meet with local elected officials to keep them up to date with recent accomplishments.
8. Several minor revisions were made to Goals 6 & 7 (see attached).
9. Ms. Leonard committed to provide some basic content for the web site.

The next meeting is scheduled for November 21st. The meeting adjourned at 10:55 a.m.
