**1. Minutes were approved**

Holly East moved approval, Linda Saul-Sena 2<sup>nd</sup> approved minutes with no changes.

2. Trail name – “Courtney Campbell Scenic Trail” -- Ron Rotella asked for “Recreation Trail” – there was much discussion – Motion by Linda Saul-Sena to just call it “Courtney Campbell Scenic Trail” – 2<sup>nd</sup> by Ken Hoyt (Clearwater City Council voted for “Trail.”)
3. Chris Weber, Westshore Alliance, opposed, everyone else – for.
4. Holly East reminded that all local governments to agree on name for signs.
5. Linda will call Harry Cohen to bring the issue to Tampa City Council
6. Holly East will send it to all four governmental units.
7. Amenity plan ready to take our local governments.
8. C.J. asked scope of subcommittee's responsibility.
9. Brian (FDOT) approved plan and prices were reasonable – ask for Debbie Hunt to be involved.
10. Ron Gregory said that Trail and Causeway belong to FDOT so they have to be central to the discussion of enhancements. Holly East suggested we use the word “Enhancements for Committee. Bill agreed to talk with Debbie Hunt.

11. Linda Saul-Sena moved and Ken Hoyt suggested that the “Courtney Campbell Public – Private Partnership Subcommittee” will pursue the funding of amenities and enhancements along the Courtney Campbell Trail.
12. Karla has already asked for modest funding from the City of Tampa to fund amenities.
13. No presentation has been made to the Hillsborough or Pinellas MPO’s – will pursue putting it on MPO agenda
14. Holly East will put it on the Hillsborough County MPO’s agenda
15. Susan Miller will ask MPO Director to put it on agenda.
16. Bill Jonson will talk to Karen Seel’s assistant about getting on the agenda
17. Create a PowerPoint presentation
18. Holly East suggests a presentation subcommittee with C.J. and Linda Saul-Sena. Linda will Chair the subcommittee. The following make up the subcommittee participants: Chris Weber, Westhore Alliance; Karla Price, City of Tampa; Bill Jonson, City of Clearwater
19. Bill Jonson suggests that we “tell an informational story.”
20. Holly suggested a presentation will last – 11 slides & 7 minutes total presentation with time after for Q&A.
21. C.J. was requested to bring an outline of Plan for Public-Private Committee.
22. Fishermen sent letter to Bill Jonson & FDOT. Discussion ensued and conclusion was to send these concerns to FDOT. We encourage collaboration.
23. Karla & Felicia worked together and presented a complete list of student opportunities (create attachment for notes.)
