3. Aug 17, 2018 Meeting Minutes were approved
4. Old Business
 - a. Westshore Alliance –the Westshore Transportation Action Plan, with rocky point sidewalks being identified as pedestrian priorities and a shuttle service, which was approved and accepted by the Hillsborough MPO on Oct 2. Right of way acquisition is still a concern, landowners would have to donate land and move utilities. Interested parties will meet prior to the end of the year.
 - b. trail amenities
 - i. Clearwater- performed site visit with AECOM, chosen 4 areas for amenities, footprints may limit opportunities to accommodate FDOT requirements. AECOM is working on site plans and should complete by the end of the year. Upon approval by DOT construction can be planned.
 - c. Sidewalk gap on north side of causeway- design in 2020, construction 2021.

5. New Business

- a. Pedestrian overpass- baseline design expected to be completed in Fall 2018. Various section designs are being considered, with alternatives presented the CCSHCAC. Alternative 5 appeared to the preference of the group. A copy of the presentation will be disseminated to the group, but should not yet be shared broadly at this time.
- b. Port Tampa permit- Project 16-021. There has been concern from the community regarding a proposed project on the south side of the Courtney Campbell. Initial permits have been approved with will need to be re-noticed to accommodate change to the scope for additional pilings and boat lifts. Will impact the scenic highway viewshed. Ron will write up material to send to the group to poll for further action, to be taken based on consensus of the group.
 - i. Through a process that will be determined, the CCSHCAC wants to be notified of future projects that are sited near the Courtney Campbell.
- c. Annual workplan- basic workplan updated during at the end of meeting and will be finished up by TBRPC staff.
