### Principal Planner, GIS

**Description:** The Tampa Bay Regional Planning Council is accepting applications for the position of Principal Planner, GIS. This is a specialized professional position that will be responsible for providing GIS modeling and mapping support for land use, environmental, public safety, and economic analysis studies and plans. Substantive knowledge of any of those fields is essential. A proven track record in writing and managing successful grants is highly desirable.

This job requires the complete maintenance of an Enterprise GIS system, including concurrent use licenses and single use licenses of ArcGIS for end users. Configuration of GIS Server and Portal with public web access, troubleshooting GIS workstations and software are job requirements. Management of geodatabases and corporate user GIS files and layers is high on the list of ongoing activities.

**Minimum qualifications include:** Master's degree in Geospatial Science or equivalent from an accredited college or university and five years of experience; or Bachelor's degree in Geospatial Science or equivalent and five years of experience. A combination of education, training, and experience may be substituted.

- ≈ Five years of experience in maintaining, planning, running GIS systems in an agency or business supporting greater than three users.
- ≈ Thorough knowledge of ArcGIS Enterprise.
